Mr. Wilmsmeyer updated the Members regarding several "good news" items at the Port. The Madison Harbor has been busy with container-on-barge moves over the last couple of weeks with several barges being loaded with empty containers destined for the Gulf. Several grant awards have been made to the benefit of the Port: A \$650,000 Opportunity Zone grant for Fourth Street reconstruction; a \$2.5 million EDA grant for grain bins and conveyor upgrades at the Madison Harbor; and a \$20.86 million BUILD grant was awarded, via SCF, which will include approximately \$15.8 million in improvements to both the Granite City and Madison Harbors. Bldg. 202 renovation is nearing completion and we have received a Notice to Proceed from EDA for Bldg. 203 renovations. Mr. Wilmsmeyer thanked Mayor Hamm for the City of Madison's continuing consideration of using TIF funds to match the Opportunity Zone grant at 50 percent.

There being no further business to come before the Board, Mr. Hamm moved that the Meeting be adjourned. Mr. Palus seconded and, with all Members present and voting Aye, Chairman declared motion passed and approved.
