Re: P22-LAND-01 Kienstra 42 Storm Sewer CIPP

America's Central Port staff submitted a mitigation project as part of the 2019 FEMA Flood Disaster Claim which was approved and is eligible for FEMA reimbursement. The scope of this project is to install 650-feet of CIPP (cured in place pipe) lining to a section of 42-inch storm sewer pipe to prevent infiltration and joint separation during periods of high ground water levels.

The project was advertised in the Belleville News Democrat on November 9<sup>th</sup> 2022 and posted on America's Central Port Plan room. Sealed bids were due and publicly opened on December 5<sup>th</sup> 2022 at 10:00am.

The bid results are as follows:

After review, Staff recommends that Insituform LLC be awarded as the lowest responsible bidder for the above-mentioned project with a lump sum bid of \$217,700.00. A standard 10% contingency of \$21,770.00 will be allocated to this project for unforeseen circumstances.
